

PUMPKIN WALK

October 1 - October 31



A Bainbridge Island tradition continues with our 27th Annual Pumpkin Walk. This year, the Trail of Pumpkins will be open for the entire month of October, decorated with hundreds of painted pumpkins and family-friendly Halloween scenes. Pumpkin Walk will be held during daytime business hours. The "Great Pumpkin" will be here (you'll need to take your own photos in our "reduced contact" setting). The bounce house, food, live music, and other activities are postponed until 2021.

WHAT YOU CAN DO:

Paint a pumpkin anytime during the month of October and bring it in to place on the trail. Visit often to see the new entries!

Dress up in your Halloween costume and take photos of your kids, yourself, (your dog) along the trail. Can't be there in person? Participate virtually. Share your photos on Instagram #PumpkinWalk2020.

Donate to the Bainbridge Island Boys and Girls Club. Our local Boys and Girls Club has been the beneficiary of the Pumpkin Walk for years. The Club has remained open, giving families of essential workers a safe place for their kids. We also thank Port Madison Enterprises for co-sponsoring the Pumpkin Walk this year.

- Thousands of pounds of pumpkins are here, as well as straw bales, corn stalks, and decorative squash.
- Replant container gardens with fall favorites, including kale, mums, and pansies.
- It's time to choose daffodils, tulips, crocus and other spring blooming bulbs for fall planting.
- For bloom indoors during the winter months, plant amaryllis and fragrant Paperwhite narcissus.
- Plants that perform in fall and winter take center stage now: winter-blooming Camellias, smoky-leaved Cotinus, purple-berried Callicarpa, fragrant Sarcococca, and heucheras in shades of bronze, red and chartruese.



Create privacy with a natural screen of plants and trees. There are so many more options than a laurel hedge. Ask for suggestions. Fall is the best time to transplant trees and shrubs. As air temperatures drop, roots grow vigorously in the still warm soil. Seasonal rain helps establish a strong root system, so when spring comes, plants are ready for a surge of new growth.

There's no charge for use of our machines.


You need to purchase a wreath ring and make a reservation for a time slot on one of our 16 machines.

Greens are sold by the pound and we have a festive collection of ribbon, pinecones, and holiday decor to add the finishing touch.

This year, please keep your wreath making group to no more than eight. Materials may be shared by members of same households only. At the time of booking, we may ask a few more questions in order to separate wreath making groups appropriately. Masks are required on the premises. Please remember to bring your own pruners and gloves. If you feel unwell or have been exposed to someone who may be unwell, we ask that you reschedule.



As Fall approaches, we are planning to proceed with some of our most well-attended events, with modifications, of course. We thank you in advance for your patience and understanding as we try to do our part to keep our staff and community safe and healthy.

Keep your edible garden going by planting garlic now for harvest at the end of summer next year. 'Inchelium Red' is a soft neck variety that easily produces large dense bulbs. Shallots and onions are planted now too.

Try overwintering kale, mustards, and fava beans. Depending on our winter, sometimes damage can occur, but with success, you'll have fresh veggies in late February or March.
